Mainline fiber construction is currently underway in Gibbon, Litchfield, Ravenna and Shelton with some areas being fiber ready at this time.

With the mainline fiber construction now complete in many of our communities, we are working to convert any current DSL or copper telephone customers to fiber service. As we work through the different areas to convert those customers, we will retire the current copper lines. **When we contact you to upgrade your Hamilton service, please schedule an appointment to avoid any potential service disruption as we complete this project.**

BLUEBERRY MUFFIN COOKIES

INGREDIENTS

6.5 ounces butter, softened
1 cup sugar
3/4 cup brown sugar
3 eggs
1 Tbsp. vanilla
3 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
3 Tbsp. cornstarch
3/4 tsp. baking powder
1 1/2 tsp. baking soda
3/4 tsp. salt
3/4 cup blueberries
3 Tbsp. blueberry jam

Streusel

4 1/2 Tbsp. butter, melted
3 Tbsp. brown sugar
2 Tbsp. sugar
3/4 cup all-purpose flour
Pinch of salt
Pinch of cinnamon

DIRECTIONS

Streusel: Whisk together dry ingredients, then add melted butter until crumbly.

Cookies:

1. Whisk together flour, cornstarch, baking powder, baking soda and salt in large mixing bowl.
2. Cream butter and sugars together until fluffy.
3. Add eggs and vanilla.
4. Add dry ingredients.
5. Toss blueberries with one tablespoon of flour and gently fold into dough.
6. Scoop out dough onto sheet trays, flatten each ball with your hand.
7. Swirl each cookie with a dot of blueberry jam and top with streusel topping.
8. Bake at 325° for 10 minutes or until edges are golden brown.
