Fiber Construction Update



Beware of Scams this Holiday Season

It seems every month there is a new scam or fraud alert to watch out for. It is important to be aware, alert and know what to watch out for so that you do not become a victim to the most recent scams. Here is a list of some of the most common scams occurring now:

1. AI-Generated Phishing Emails

Scammers now use AI to craft highly convincing phishing emails that mimic trusted contacts or brands. These emails may include personalized details, making them harder to detect.



2. Deepfake Voice & Video Scams

Cybercriminals impersonate executives or family members via voice or video, often requesting urgent financial transfers or sensitive data. These scams are especially dangerous in business settings where a fake “boss” call can lead to costly errors.

3. QR Code Phishing (Quishing)

Hackers embed malicious QR codes in emails, posters or fake customer service messages. When scanned, these codes redirect users to phishing sites or install malware.

4. Fake Tech Support & Remote Access Scams

Scammers impersonate support agents from companies like Microsoft or Apple, claiming your device is infected. They then request remote access, steal data or demand payment.

5. Impersonation & Investment Scams

These scams involve fraudsters posing as government officials, executives or celebrities to solicit money or sensitive data.

Ingredients:

- 1 (16 oz. frozen) whipped topping, thawed OR 6 cups fresh whipped cream
- 1 (5 oz. package) instant vanilla pudding mix
- 1 (15 oz. can) solid pack pumpkin
- 1 ¼ tsp. pumpkin pie spice, adjust this to how "pumpkiny" you want it

Directions:

In a large bowl, mix together instant vanilla pudding mix, pumpkin and pumpkin pie spice. Fold in the thawed whipped topping or fresh whipped cream. Chill in the refrigerator until serving. Serve with apples, ginger snaps, vanilla wafers or cinnamon graham crackers. Store leftover dip in an airtight container in the fridge.
